Dr. Robert Wilson is a Professor in the Department of Neurological Sciences and Department of Behavioral Sciences at Rush University Medical Center. His research has focused on modeling late life change in cognitive function; identifying traits of one's earlier life and consequences of cognitive loss in old age.

With a growing emphasis on facilitating brain health, Dr. Wilson's lecture will review evidence from ongoing clinical-pathologic studies linking aspects of life experience with risk of dementia and cognitive decline in old age and consider the neurobiologic bases of these assumptions.
